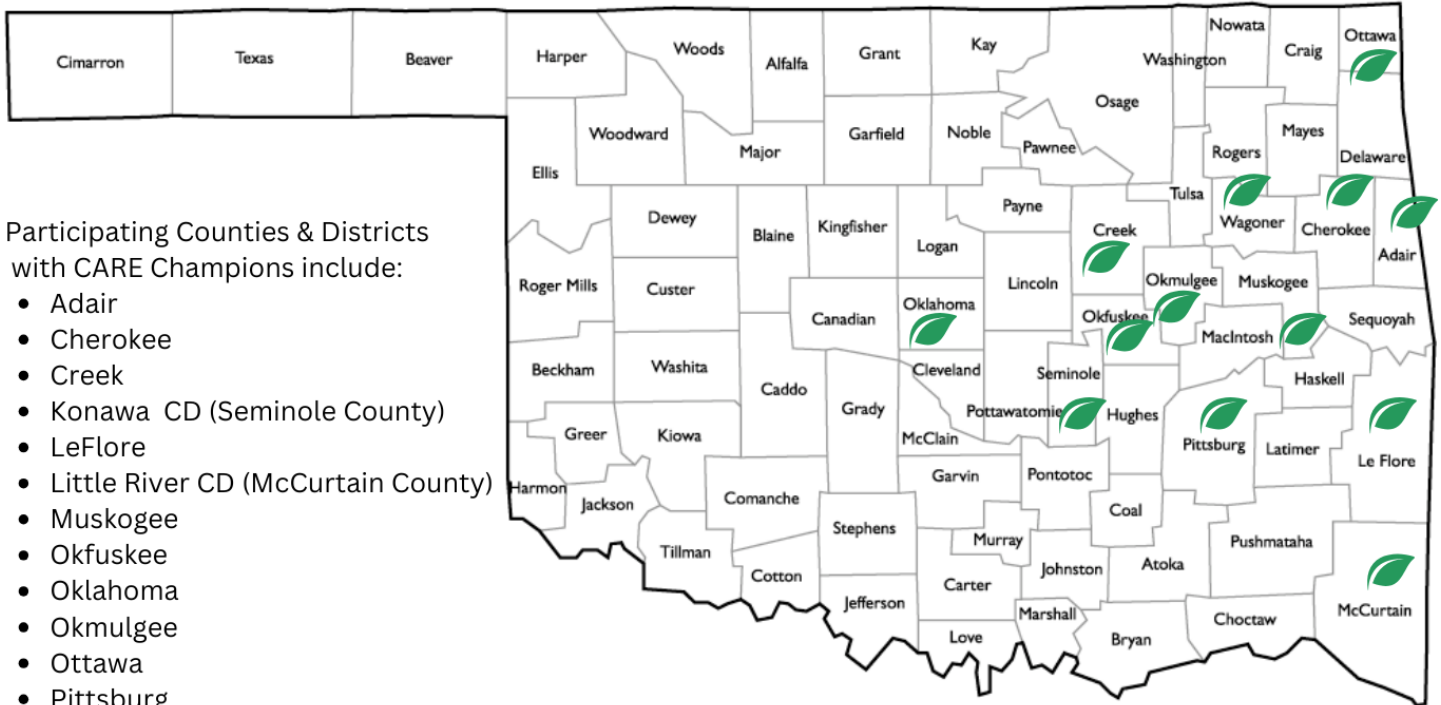

The aim of CARE is to to increase participation in NRCS and state conservation programs among socially disadvantaged and veteran farmers and ranchers. CARE is implemented through local conservation districts to deliver comprehensive conservation planning that focuses on improvements to soil health and water quality.
